FORMAT: Better Ball of Partners Championship. (8 stroke Handicap Differential. Partners may have a larger differential, however the higher handicap partner will play down to maintain the 8-stroke difference) the field will be flighted. Awards will be given to 1/3 of the field in gross and net.

Eligibility: Open to players with a valid USGA handicap index who are members of SDCWGA by September 7, 2009.

Entry Fee: **\$145.00 per person.** Entry Fee includes, green fees, carts, range balls, awards and Luncheon to be held at Shadowridge on Friday December 4. No refunds after October 4. See refund policy on page 33 in the SDCWGA Handbook.

Pairings: Pairings sheets will be available on our web sit <http://www.golfsdcwga.org>. If you would like the pairings sheet mailed to you, include a self addressed stamped envelope with your entry.

Substitutions: Tournament Director **MUST** be notified of a partner substitution (illness or family emergency) at least 72 hours before the start of play. Failure to do so may result in substitute player's score not being allowed in the competition. Later substitutions may be accepted upon Committee Review.

Dress Code: Players wearing short shorts, jeans, tank tops, sorts without collars, or any inappropriate attire will not be allowed on the golf course. A player with short shorts deemed inappropriate may be asked to purchase an acceptable pair in the Pro Shop. For more detailed information please read page 26 in the SDCWGA Handbook.

Note: The use of cell phone or pagers during a stipulated round is not allowed. Infringement of this policy may impact eligibility for future SDCWGA Events. If you do not arrive at your starting point on the golf course ready to play, within five minutes of your starting time, the penalty for failure to start on time is two strokes at the first hole in stroke play. The only exception will be unanticipated dire circumstances, subject to review by the Rules Committee. The Course may require cart paths only if conditions warrant.
