- Format:** Better Ball of Partner first 6 holes, two person scramble second 6 holes and modified Scotch(alternate shot) third 6 holes. Maximum 8 stroke handicap differential between partners (higher handicap partner may enter with handicap reduced to meet the requirement) The field will be flighted. Awards will be given to 1/3 of the field in gross and net.
- Eligibility:** Open to players with a USGA handicap index who are members on SDCWGA by Jan 11, 2010.
- Entry Fee:** **\$77 per person.** Entry Fee includes, green fees, carts and awards. Range Cards will be available for \$3.00. No refunds after Feb 7. See refund policy in the SDCWGA Handbook. Make checks payable to SDCWGA.

- Dress Code:** Can be found in the SDCWGA Handbook. Golf course requirements also apply. No jeans, jogging shorts, sweats, T shirts or tank tops. Shorts must be appropriate length. A player with shorts deemed inappropriate may be asked to purchase an acceptable pair in the pro shop.
- Substitution:** Notify the Tournament Director of a partner substitution (illness or family emergency) at least 72 hours before the start of play. Failure to do so may result in substitute player's score not allowed in the competition. Later substitutions may be accepted upon Committee Review.
- Note:** The use of cell phone or pagers during a stipulated round is NOT allowed. Infringement of this policy may impact eligibility in future SDCWGA Events. If you do not arrive at your starting point on the golf course, ready to play, within five minutes of your starting time, the penalty for failure to start on time is two strokes at the first hole in stroke play. The only exception will be unanticipated dire circumstances, subject to review by the Rules Committee. Courses may require cart paths only, if conditions warrant.
