- ELIGIBILITY:** Membership dues must be paid/postmarked or processed at least 15 days prior to the opening date.
- FORMAT:** **Partner Event.** BBC Score Better Ball on first and second holes, then combined scores for third hole. Continue this pattern. The Field will be flighted. Entries of four cannot be guaranteed to be paired together.
- AWARDS:** Awards will be given to 1/3 of the field in gross and net. **Ties will be broken by card-off according to USGA guidelines and procedures.**
- ENTRY FEE:** **\$53 per person.** Entry fee includes green fees, cart, range balls and awards. **NO REFUND AFTER CLOSING DATE.** See SDCWGA 2010 Handbook for complete information on Field Days and the refund policy.
- ENTRY FORM:** You may enter on our web site at <http://www.golfsdcwga.org>, or use entry form located in your SDCWGA 2010 Handbook. Checks should be made out to SDCWGA. Do not mail your entry prior to August 23, 2010. Entries postmarked prior to August 23, 2010, will be placed at the end of the entry list.

Players wearing short shorts, jeans, tank tops, shirts without collars, or any inappropriate attire will not be allowed on the golf course. If you do not arrive at your starting point on the golf course, ready to play, within five minutes of your starting time, the penalty for failure to start on time is two strokes at the first hole in stroke play. The only exception will be unanticipated dire circumstances, subject to review by the Rules Committee. Course may require cart paths only, if conditions warrant.
